

Ancient Mayan City of Yaxchilan...

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Each month one sacred site or ancient wisdom teaching will be explored. Yaxchilan (place of the green stones) is a magnificent, yet remote Mayan temple site that most people are not familiar with, located on the trade route between Palenque and Tikal. It is accessible only by boat, protected in the jade green jungle of the Chiapas lowlands. There are temples with beautifully detailed carved stone lintels, labyrinths and magnificent carved reliefs depicting ceremonies performed by the ancient Mayan Lords and Lordesses in this ritual city.

Nestled in the mists of no time on the banks of the Usamacinta River (the Nile of the Americas), Yaxchilan has always held great significance and still holds many secrets yet to be revealed. Once a majestic metropolis that rivaled Palenque, the Lancondones Maya continue to make pilgrimages and perform their rituals here (Chixokla) to honor the deities, as in ancient times.

Mayan Master Teacher Miguel Angel and I will be taking a group to Yaxchilan during our Equinox journey to Palenque in September 2006, and hold ceremony there. These stories give a brief glimpse of what that energy holds. My thanks to Miguel Angel for sharing this sacred knowledge of the Maya with us.

SACRED YAXCHILAN - PLACE OF THE VISION QUEST by Miguel Angel Vergara

Welcome, all of you, to the Sacred Site of Yaxchilan. The ancient spiritual and philosophical meaning of the name is *The Place Where the Maya Received their Visions and Prophecies for the Future of Humankind*.
